

The Margaret Grant Trophy is a charity event and will be a 3 wood 6 ends drawn "Pairs Tournament" (mixed or single sex as dictated by the entries)

1. Entrants will be seeded and then drawn into pairs considering gender to maximise the number of mixed pairs. If there is an odd number of pairs any remaining entries on the list will be reserves.

2. The format will be two groups*, each consisting of a maximum of 14 pairs with each pair playing 3 random games against pairs in their group. Scoring two points for a win and one for a draw.

3. The winning pair of each group* will play in the final (6 ends not timed). If pairs in the group stage are level on points, shot difference will be the decider. If still level, the number of winning ends will be the decider.

*** The number of entries will determine the number in pairs per group and may result in only one group i.e. no final.**

4. Each game will consist of 6 ends or 45 minutes whichever is the sooner. A bell will sound after 40 minutes, after which the end being played will be the last. If the jack has not been centred, the game is finished.

5. All games will commence at the same time by the signal of the bell. No trial ends. Toss for the Jack, which should be cast and centred before the bell is rung.

6. If the jack is improperly delivered it should be placed by the opposing team at whatever length they wish, with the mat unchanged.

7. Any pair killing an end will incur a 3 shot penalty. The end will count, and the non-offending team will cast the next Jack.

8. No visits to the head are allowed
