

Rules for Covid Autumn Triples (September 2020)

1. Each Team's Skip for a match is responsible for ensuring that his team observe all the Covid precautions and that social distancing is followed at all times.
2. All players must change outside and leave their belongings outside. In the event of inclement weather each rink will have a designated indoor area to shelter.
3. To avoid any overcrowding **NO SUBSTITUTES ARE ALLOWED FROM ANOTHER TEAM SO, DON'T HANG AROUND IN THE HOPE OF GETTING A GAME.**
If a full team of three players cannot be fielded from a squad then the match should be played 9 v 8 woods with the full team starting each end. At the end of the match the incomplete team shall have 25% of their score deducted.
In the event of a team being unable to field a team they will forfeit the match with the opposition taking the two points with an assumed plus five shots score.
4. Matches to be played on Mondays with either a 10.00 or 13.00 start (ready or not!)
Play will last for two hours and will start and end on the bell.
If the Jack has been centred the end to be completed.
5. The first named team on the fixture list will be the Home team and will have the mat.
The Home Skip will complete the only **score-card which must show all players full names as this is part of the track and trace procedures required by law.**
There is no need for the card to be signed and after the match it should be put into the box provided in the conservatory.
6. Play generally in accordance with World Bowls "Laws of the Sport Bowls".
If the jack is improperly delivered it will be placed by the opposing team at whatever length they wish with the mat left unchanged.
In the event of a dead end- 2 shots to be awarded to the opposition.
7. In the event of a match being abandoned, if over one hour has been played then the score at the time of the abandonment will stand as the match result.
